WHAT IS DOMESTIC ABUSE?

Domestic abuse can be any abuse that happens in a personal or a family relationship.

The abuse might be physical, sexual, emotional, financial or, more likely, a combination of these. It can involve a whole range of controlling behaviours ranging from threats and general harassment to actual physical abuse.

Domestic abuse can occur in any kind of family relationship – for example a son or daughter being abusive to a parent, a woman or man acting abusively to their partner and abuse in same sex relationships. In reality though, it most often involves one party's abuse of power over their partner or ex-partners, and their children.

Abuse is rarely a one-off event – it tends to get worse over time, in frequency and severity. No-one should have to put up with domestic abuse.

WORRIED ABOUT THE COST?

You may be able to obtain Legal Aid, which is now known as 'Public Funding'. This will be discussed at your first appointment.
